| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Drinking water of poor quality | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Residential water testing to include lead levels (residents would like to test their own water) ▪ Note: Lead level testing cost-\$120-\$200 |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contaminated water supply due to seepage | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Decreased water levels in streams, etc. | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Standing water after heavy rain (poor drainage system in community) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ This has been reported to WG&L officials for action |
| <u>Environment</u> | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Fumes/toxins and spills generated by two petroleum site in area with huge storage tanks ▪ Buried pipelines run near homes in Country Club Estates ▪ Lack of evacuation plan in case of a tank explosion | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Reports revealed cleanup was immediate and met all environmental standards ▪ Kinder Morgan and MAGELLAM will be contacted regarding a detailed evacuation plan in the event of an explosion |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ MacGregor site-closed golf manufacturing industry with toxins (high levels of Chromium, Hexavalent Chromium and Nickel at the site - residents feel there is no accountability for MacGregor owners ▪ The site is on Hazardous Site Inventory list for Georgia | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Who is responsible for site? ▪ Is there any remediation? ▪ Who will clean up the site? ▪ Can the site be added to the superfund site list & what is the process? |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Airport noise and fumes in residential community and near Alice Coachman Elementary School | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Meet with airport staff to discuss noise level, toxins emitted by planes, and airport expansion |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Pollutants encroaching upon elementary school from nearby tank farms (tanks meet EPA requirements) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Testing of air and ground water at school. Push for Level II site evaluation and complete testing/assessment ▪ City officials were requested to check out the site |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Runoff of pesticides from former pecan farm in residential area | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Collect air quality samples when pecan trees are sprayed ▪ Soil testing of area |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Superfund site in residential area | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ "Closed issue" |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Accumulated waste/pollutants and lack of clean-up from auto shops near residential area | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ "To be researched" |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discarded old construction debris next to closed superfund site | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Owner was cited and some clean-up has been done. The material is still present ▪ Owner can be contacted for follow-up |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Stench at water treatment plant | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Check with WG&L to see if something can be added to the water to help with the neighborhood stench |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Old landfill site at Southside Middle School | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The committee is still waiting on a reply from officials and still pursuing the issue |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Too many cancer cases in young and old on every street in community | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Complete a cancer study (research cancer data by race, 1994-2008) |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Chronic health conditions- asthma (respiratory illnesses) and diabetes | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Review EPA toolkits/programs and incorporate in communities and as school projects |
